**“RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE INTERNAL RULES AND PROCEDURES
OF THE BCPCH EN BANC MEETING”**

WHEREAS, Title XVI of Section 46 of the Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 13 otherwise known as “An Act Providing for the Bangsamoro Administrative Code and Other Related Purposes” enacted by Bangsamoro Transition Authority Parliament provides that, “The Bangsamoro Commission for the Preservation of Cultural Heritage is hereby created, composed of a Chairperson and six (6) Commissioners. It shall have the same status as the other agencies or offices of the Bangsamoro Government attached to the Office of the Chief Minister;

WHEREAS, Section 51 of the Bangsamoro Administrative Code No.13 provides that “The Commission en banc shall be composed of seven (7) Commissioners. Five (5) Commissioners shall be representatives of the major political subdivisions of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region, namely: a. Maguindanao, including Cotabato City and the 63 barangays that joined the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region; b. Lanao del Sur, including Marawi City; c. Sulu; d. Basilan, including Lamitan City; e. Tawi-Tawi. The two (2) other ex officio Commissioners shall come from the non-Moro indigenous peoples and settler communities”;

WHEREAS, as provided under Article IX, Section 24 of the Bangsamoro Organic Law states that, “The Bangsamoro Government shall preserve the history, culture, arts traditions, and the rich cultural heritage of the Bangsamoro people and their Sultanates, such as those of Sulu, Maguindanao, Kabuntalan, Buayan, the Royal House of Ranao and of the Iranun, and the non-Moro Indigenous Peoples’ of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region”;

WHEREAS, the BCPCH, in adherence to its legal mandate under Article IX, Section 25 of the Bangsamoro Organic Law states that “The Bangsamoro Commission for the Preservation of the Cultural Heritage shall have the primary responsibility to write the history of the Bangsamoro people and to establish and sustain the cultural institutions, programs, and projects in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region. The Commission shall coordinate and work closely with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts, National Historical Commission of the Philippines, National Museum of the Philippines, and other concerned cultural agencies for the preservation of cultural heritage, and shall establish libraries and museums, declare and restore historical shrines and cultural sites to preserve the Bangsamoro heritage for posterity.

The Commission shall ensure the inclusion of Philippine history, culture and heritage in the establishment of museums and similar institutions, programs and projects to foster unity among Filipinos;


