A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF MINISTER TO ALLOT FUNDING FOR THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP'S (TWG) ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS FOR THE FORMULATION OF GUIDELINES ON THE ACCREDITATION OF SULTANATE AS REQUIRED BY THE BANGSAMORO ELECTORAL CODE

WHEREAS, Article IX section 24 of the Bangsamoro Organic Law (BOL) provides that the Bangsamoro Government shall preserve the history, culture, arts traditions, and the rich cultural heritage of the Bangsamoro People and their sultanates, such as those of Sulu, Maguindanao, Kabuntalan, Buayan, the royal house of ranao and of the iranun, and the non-moro indigenous peoples of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region. For this purpose, it shall create the Bangsamoro Commission for the Preservation of Cultural Heritage in coordination with the appropriate and relevant national government agencies;

WHEREAS, Title XVI Chapter IV section 46 of the Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 13 otherwise known as Bangsamoro Administrative Code provides that the Bangsamoro Commission for the Preservation of Cultural Heritage (BCPCH) is hereby created, composed of a Chairperson and six (6) Commissioners. It shall have the same status as the other agencies or offices of the Bangsamoro Government attached to the Office of the Chief Minister.

WHEREAS, Article IV section 18 of the Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 35 otherwise known as the Bangsamoro Electoral Code provides for the registration requirement for sectoral organizations, or political parties fielding candidates for sectoral representation elections, duly registered with the commission on election, through the Bangsamoro Registration and Accreditation Committee (BRAC), may participate in the sectoral representative elections provided that such sectoral organizations for traditional leader shall be certified by the BCPCH.

WHEREAS, Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 35 further provides that within one hundred twenty (120) days from promulgation of this code, the appropriate certifying ministries and offices shall issue a corresponding guideline for the process of certification, copies of which shall be furnished to the Parliament.

WHEREAS, BCPCH as an attached agency of the office of the chief minister, the commission proper deemed it fit to request from the office of the chief minister to allot funding for the administrative cost for the formulation of guidelines on the accreditation of sultanate as required on the third and fourth paragraph of this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED, to adopt this Resolution No. 001 titled A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CHIEF MINISTER TO ALLOT FUNDING FOR THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP'S (TWG) ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS FOR THE FORMULATION OF GUIDELINES ON THE ACCREDITATION OF SULTANATE AS REQUIRED BY THE BANGSAMORO ELECTORAL CODE.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Secretariat is directed to write a letter and possible meeting with the key officials of the office of the Chief Minister for this purpose.
