A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE SURVEY QUESTIONNAIRE FOR THE PROFILING OF TRADITIONAL LEADERS

WHEREAS, the BCPCH is created by virtue of Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 13 otherwise known as “An Act Providing for the Bangsamoro Administrative Code and Other Related Purposes” as enacted by Bangsamoro Transition Authority Parliament;

WHEREAS, Section 24, Article IX of Republic Act No. 11054, otherwise known as the “Organic Law of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (Bangsamoro Organic Law),” states that the Bangsamoro Government shall preserve the history, culture, arts, traditions, and the rich cultural heritage of the Bangsamoro people and their Sultanates, such as those of Sulu, Maguindanao, Kabuntalan, Buayan, the Royal House of Lanao and of the Iranun, and the non-Moro Indigenous peoples of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region;

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 7(c) of Republic Act No. 11054 and Section 15, Article IV-C of the Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 35, otherwise known as “An Act Providing for the Bangsamoro Electoral Code of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao,” provides that the reserved seats and sectoral representatives shall constitute at least ten percent (10%) of the members of the Parliament, which shall include two (2) reserved seats each for non-Moro indigenous peoples and settler communities. Women, youth, traditional leaders, and the *Ulama* shall have one sectoral seat each: *Provided*, That the reserved seats and sectoral representatives shall in no case be less than eight (8) seats;

WHEREAS, Section 18, Article IV-C of the Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 35 provides for the registration requirement of the sectoral organizations of traditional leaders which includes the certification of the sectors by the Bangsamoro Commission for the Preservation of Cultural Heritage (BCPCH);

WHEREAS, Section 31, Article IV-E of the Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 35 provides for the manner of election of traditional leaders wherein the BCPCH shall hold a regional convention of Sultans representing the Sultanates of: a) Sulu, b) Maguindanao, Kabuntalan, and Buayan, c) Lanao, and d) Iranun for the purpose of determining the order by which each of the Sultanate shall represent the sector in the Parliament;

WHEREAS, it is essential for the BCPCH to profile the sectoral organizations of traditional leaders to establish a data bank of Traditional Leaders of Sultanates of Sulu, Maguindanao, Kabuntalan, Buayan, the Royal House of Lanao and of the Iranun of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region;

WHEREAS, in order to have an effective and efficient selection of traditional leader that will represent in the Parliament, the survey questionnaire for the profiling of traditional leaders must be adopted;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE SURVEY QUESTIONNAIRE FOR THE PROFILING OF TRADITIONAL LEADERS.
