#### RESOLUTION NO. 017 Series of 2023

#### RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE APPROVED CEILING FOR THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE BANGSAMORO COMMISSION FOR THE PRESERVATION OF CULTURAL HERITAGE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024

**WHEREAS**, Article IX section 24 of the Bangsamoro Organic Law (BOL) provides that the Bangsamoro Government shall preserve the history, culture, arts traditions, and the rich cultural heritage of the Bangsamoro People and their sultanates, such as those of Sulu, Maguindanao, Kabuntalan, Buayan, the royal house of ranao and of the iranun, and the non-moro indigenous peoples of the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region. For this purpose, it shall create the Bangsamoro Commission for the Preservation of Cultural Heritage in coordination with the appropriate and relevant national government agencies;

**WHEREAS**, Title XVI Chapter IV section 46 of the Bangsamoro Autonomy Act No. 13 otherwise known as Bangsamoro Administrative Code provides that the Bangsamoro Commission for the Preservation of Cultural Heritage (BCPCH) is hereby created, composed of a Chairperson and six (6) Commissioners. It shall have the same status as the other agencies or offices of the Bangsamoro Government attached to the Office of the Chief Minister.

**WHEREAS**, Title XVI chapter IV section 47 of the Bangsamoro Autonomy Act number 13 provides that the BCPCH shall have the primary responsibility to write the history of the Bangsamoro people and to establish and sustain the cultural institutions, programs, and projects in the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region. The Commission shall coordinate and work closely with the National Commission for Culture and the Arts, National Historical Commission of the Philippines, National Museum of the Philippines, and other concerned cultural agencies for the preservation of cultural heritage, shall establish libraries and museums, declare and restore historical shrines and cultural sites to preserve the Bangsamoro heritage for posterity. The Commission shall ensure the inclusion of Philippine history, culture and heritage in the Page 177 establishment of museums and similar institutions, programs and projects to foster unity among the Filipinos.

**WHEREAS**, the total amount approved ceiling for the annual budget of the Bangsamoro Commission for the Preservation of Cultural Heritage for the Fiscal Year 2024 in the Bangsamoro Expenditure Program (BEP) is **One Hundred Three Million and Ten Thousand Four Hundred Thirty-Nine Pesos (P103,001,439.00)** subject to its finality upon the approval of the Bangsamoro Transition Authority - Parliament. The breakdown are the following;

1. <i>Personnel Services</i>	<b>41,356,314.00</b>
2. <i>Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses</i>	<b>60,700,125.00</b>
3. <i>Capital Outlay</i>	<b>945,000.00</b>
